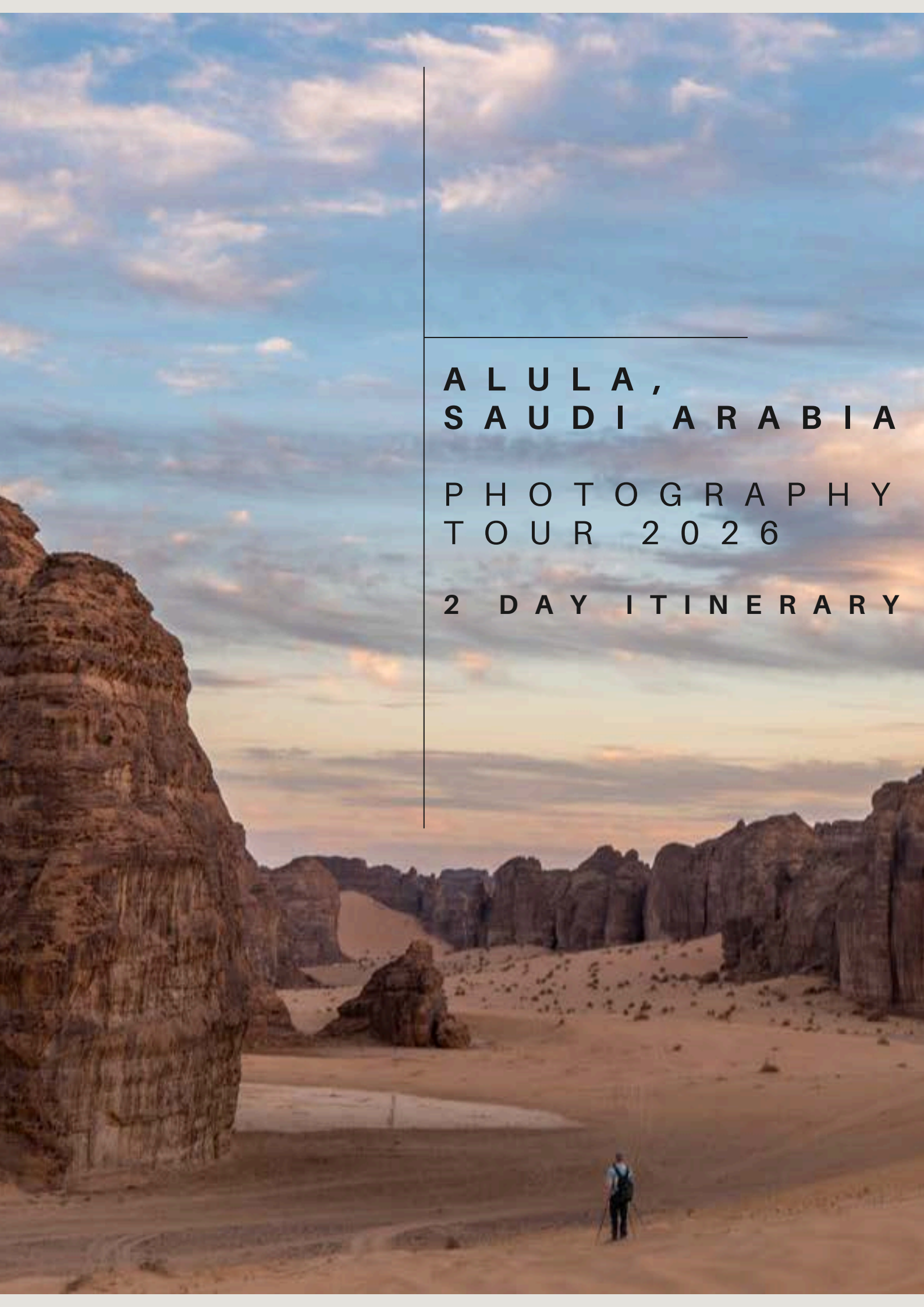

Heritage, Nature, Culture and Landscape

Located in the northwestern region of Saudi Arabia, AlUla's vast, ancient desert terrains feature dramatic red sandstone mountains, canyons, and unique rock formations like Elephant Rock and Gharameel. This desert backdrop is interspersed with a fertile oasis of two million palm trees and fields of black volcanic basalt.

Within the dramatic landscape are live archaeological areas, UNESCO World Heritage sites and an Old Town housing over 900 mud-brick buildings

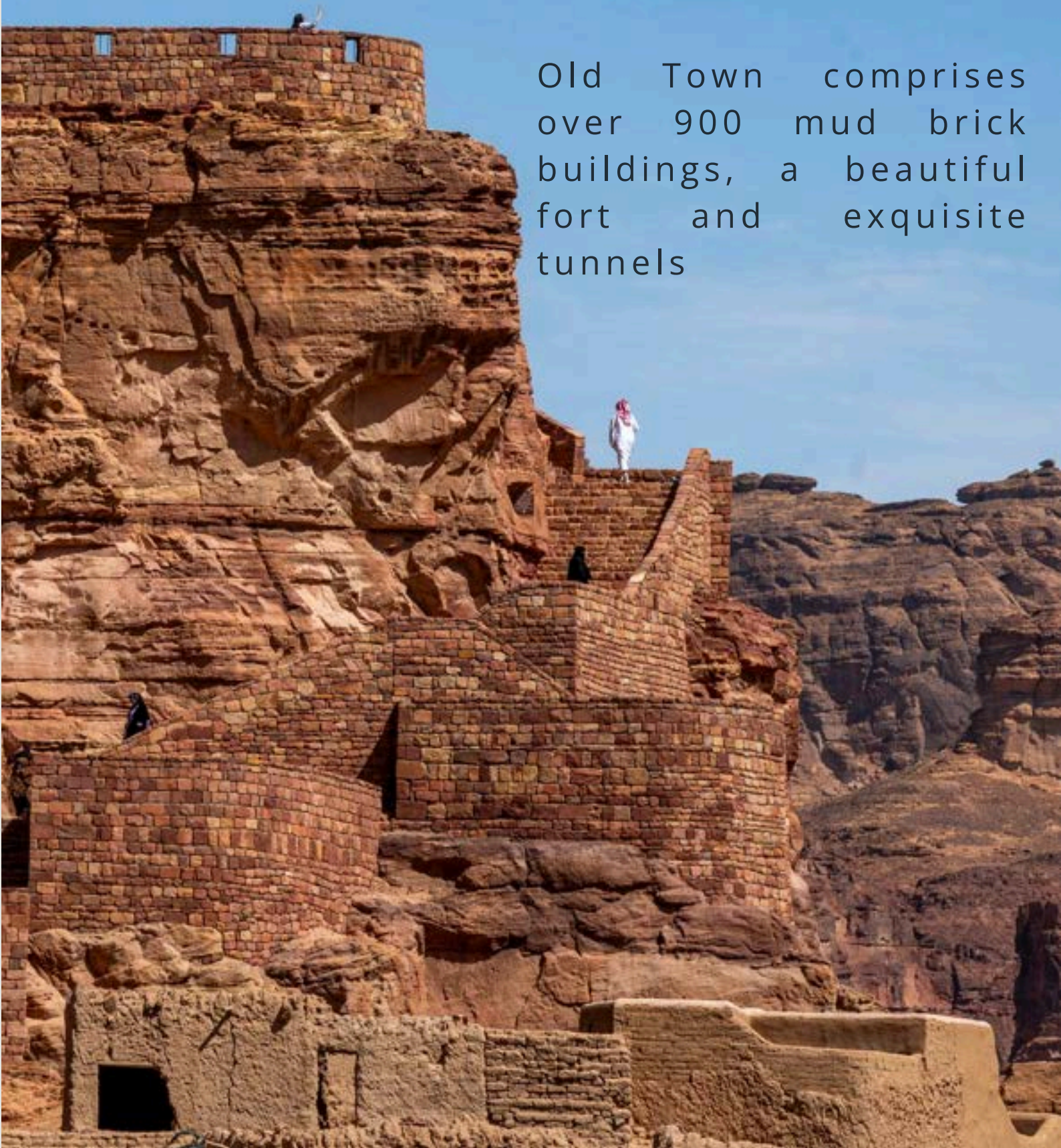

Old Town comprises over 900 mud brick buildings, a beautiful fort and exquisite tunnels

DAY 1: OASIS



AlUla's Oasis consists of over 2 million palm trees and dozens of mud-brick Summer farms.

We will capture the sunlight breaking through the trees, shadows across the landscape and the ruins of the buildings.

DAY 1: MARAYA & ASHAR

Maraya is the world's largest mirrored building, designed to reflect AlUla's desert landscape.

We can shoot it from many angles, with the reflections of the mountains in the mirrors providing multiple unique shots

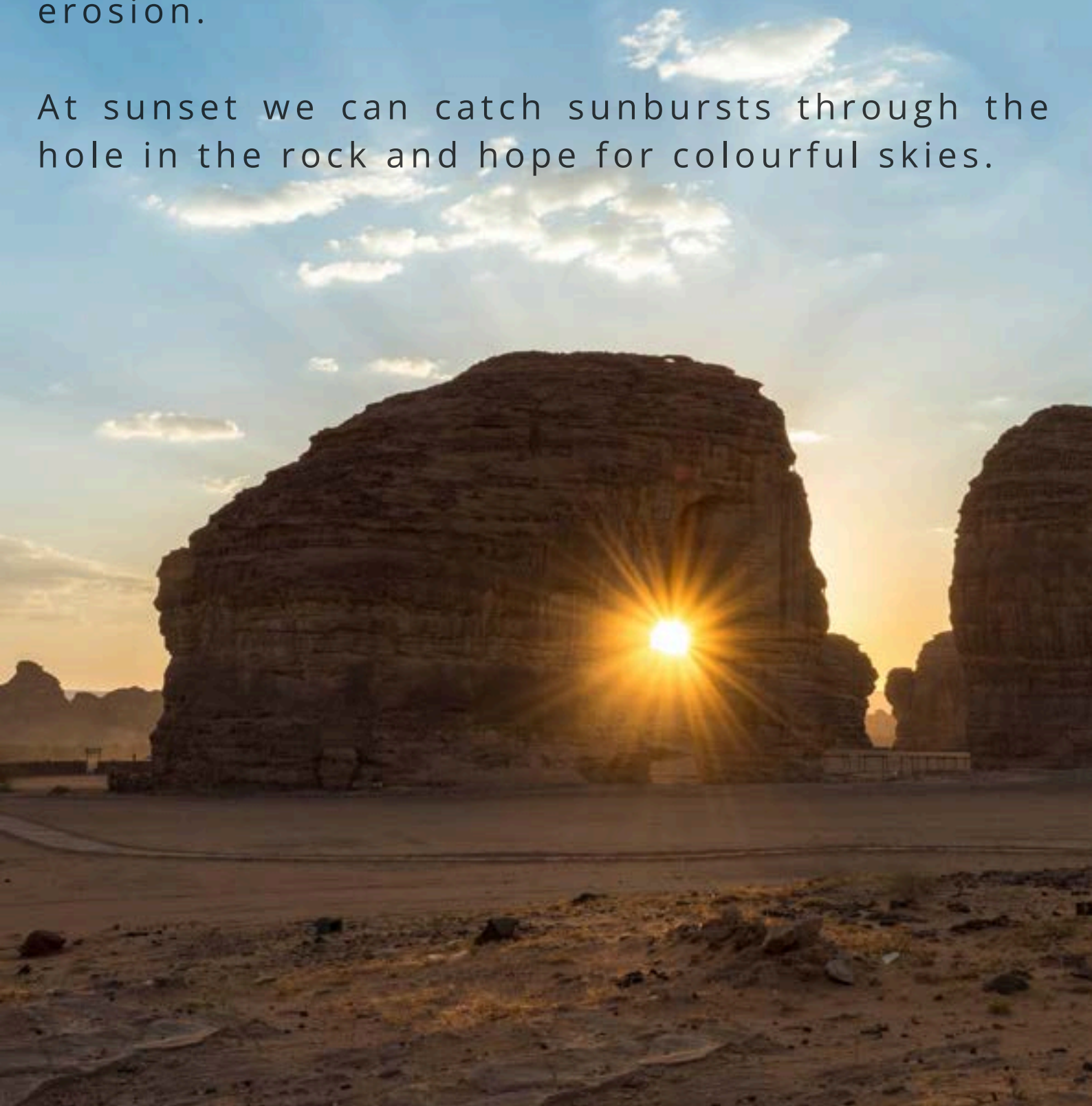

D A Y 1 : E L E P H A N T R O C K

Elephant Rock is a naturally formed, 52-meter-tall sandstone landmark shaped like an elephant by millions of years of wind and water erosion.

At sunset we can catch sunbursts through the hole in the rock and hope for colourful skies.



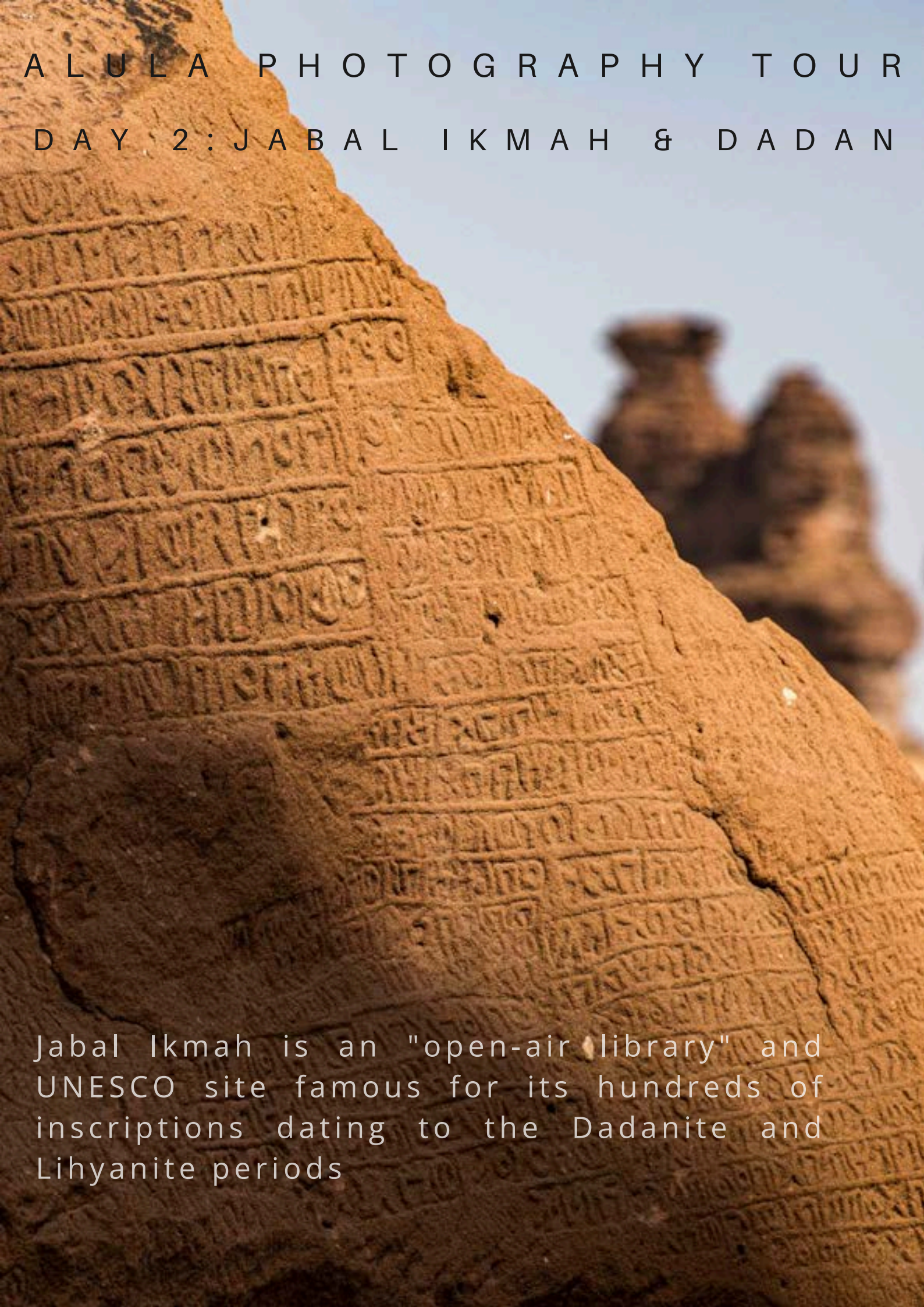

DAY 1: RAINBOW ROCK

AlUla is Saudi Arabia's first International Dark Sky Park, offering spectacular, unpolluted views of the night sky with constellations, stars, and the Milky Way

DAY 2: HARRAT VIEWPOINT

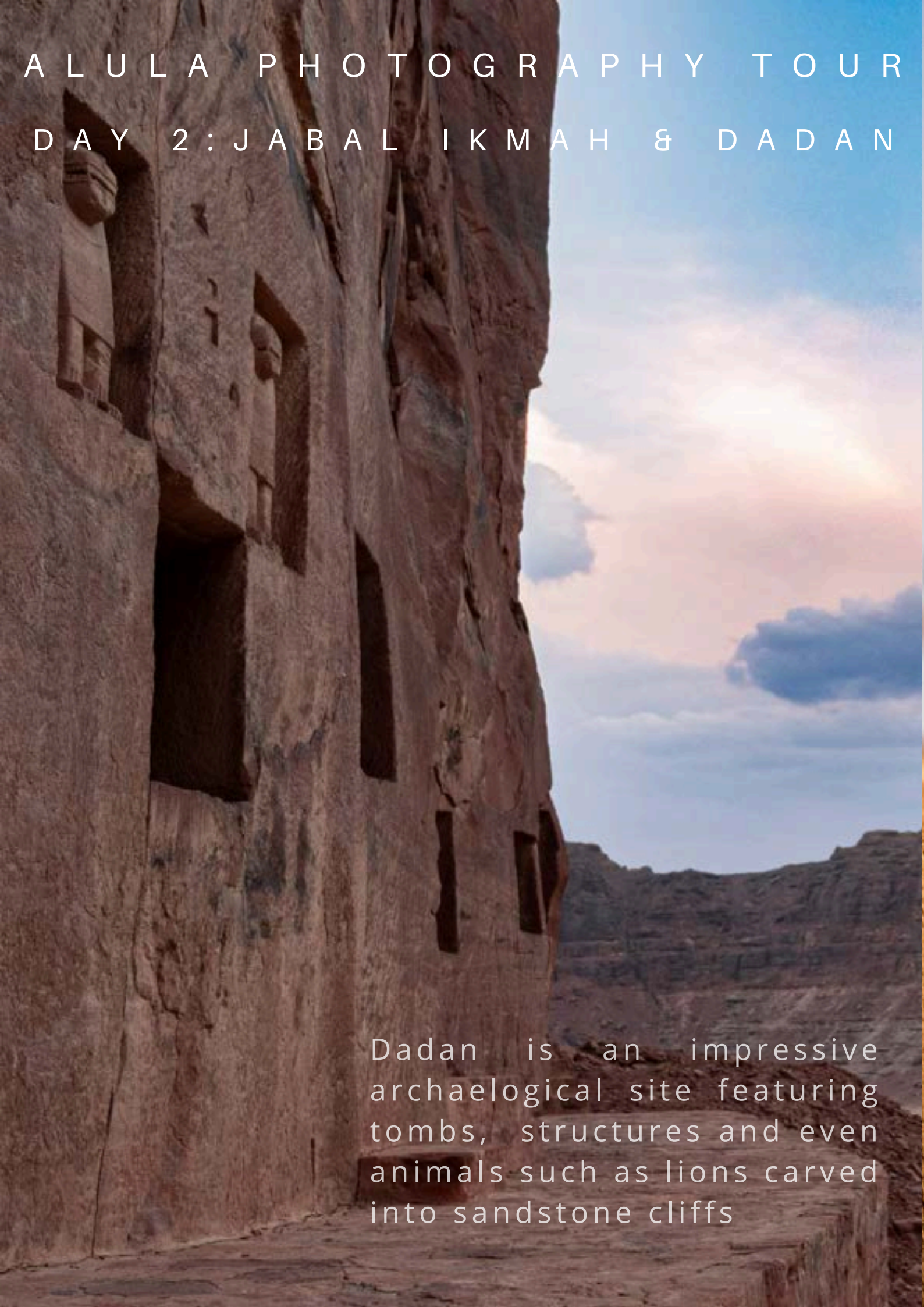
Potentially the best view in Alula. We will watch the sun rise over the black volcanic Harrat and shoot over the city from the Viewpoint

D A Y 2 : J A B A L I K M A H & D A D A N

Jabal Ikamah is an "open-air library" and UNESCO site famous for its hundreds of inscriptions dating to the Dadanite and Lihyanite periods

D A Y 2 : J A B A L I K M A H & D A D A N

Dadan is an impressive archaeological site featuring tombs, structures and even animals such as lions carved into sandstone cliffs

ALULA PHOTOGRAPHY TOUR

DAY 2: SHALAL

Shalal is known for towering slot canyons and rocky formations. We will trek through the canyons, seeking out light from the sun breaking through from above

DAY 2: ACACIA TREES

AlUla's native Acacia species are essential for desert ecosystems and providing shade. We will often see camels resting and eating here, against the backdrop of huge mountains

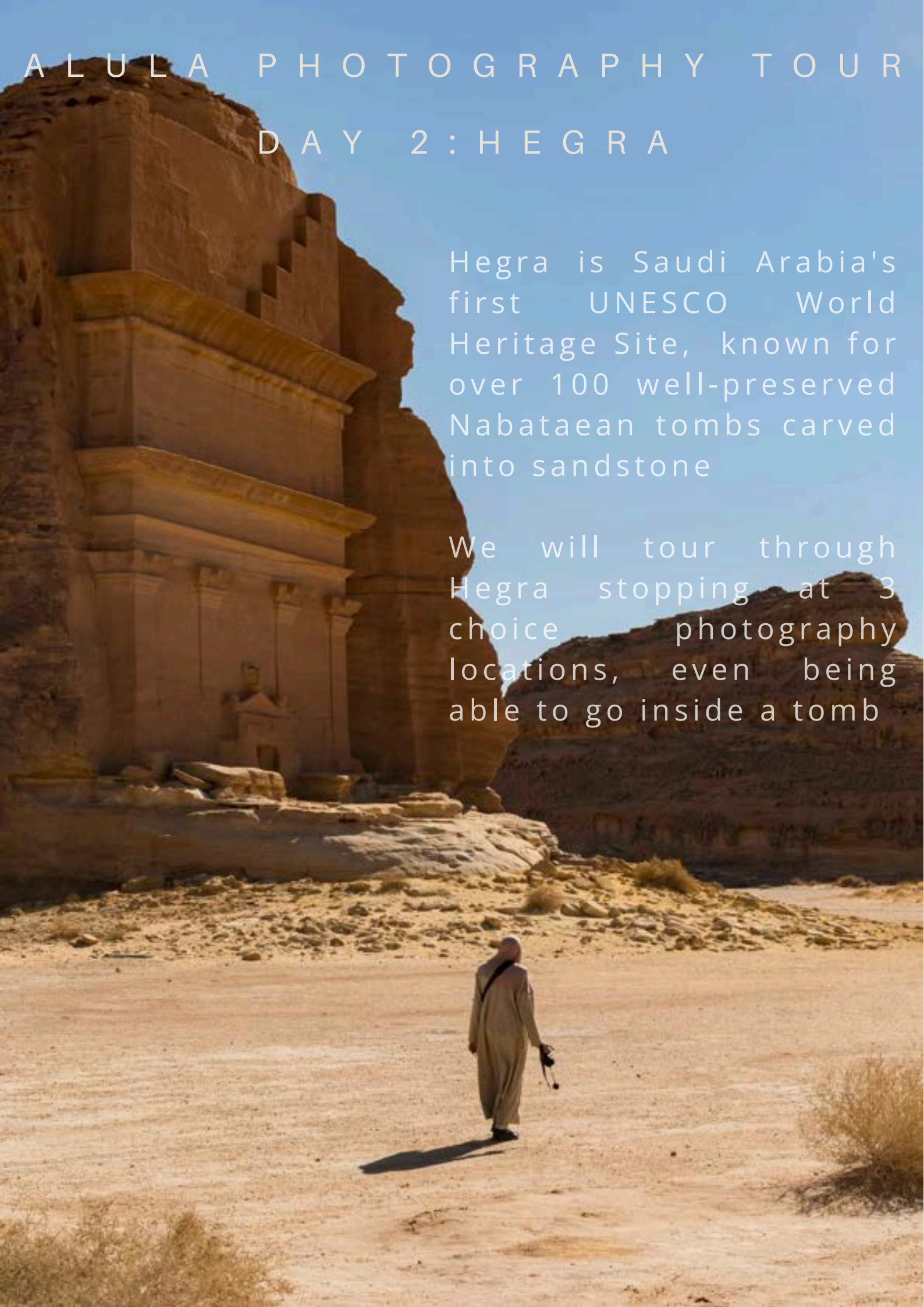


ALULA PHOTOGRAPHY TOUR

DAY 2: HEGRA

Hegra is Saudi Arabia's first UNESCO World Heritage Site, known for over 100 well-preserved Nabataean tombs carved into sandstone

We will tour through Hegra stopping at 3 choice photography locations, even being able to go inside a tomb

D A Y 2 : G H A R A M E E L

Gharameel Reserve features towering, geometric rock formations shaped by wind and erosion. Known for its dark skies, it's a prime spot for stargazing and astrophotography.

We will shoot the milky way against a backdrop of impressive monoliths amongst minimal light pollution.

W H A T T O B R I N G

Key Kit

Camera, Lens & Tripod - recommend wide angle, regular 24-70mm types and zoom

Filters - particularly ND for sun and sand

Photography bag / backpack

Memory cards, batteries, chargers etc

Camera cleaning gear - sand gets places!

Saudi riyals in case of issues with bank cards

Clothing.

The temperatures can be warm during the day in December (22-27 degrees in the day) but the nights are cold (6-10 degrees)

Hiking/desert shoes & socks, shorts, t-shirts, lightweight trousers, shirts & tops. Insulated jacket (and gloves if you wish) for evening shoots and a hat & sunglasses for the day.

Comfortable clothes for dining out

Headlamp for night photography

Optional

Hiking poles, laptop, books etc

Do not bring.

Drone - it will not get into the country

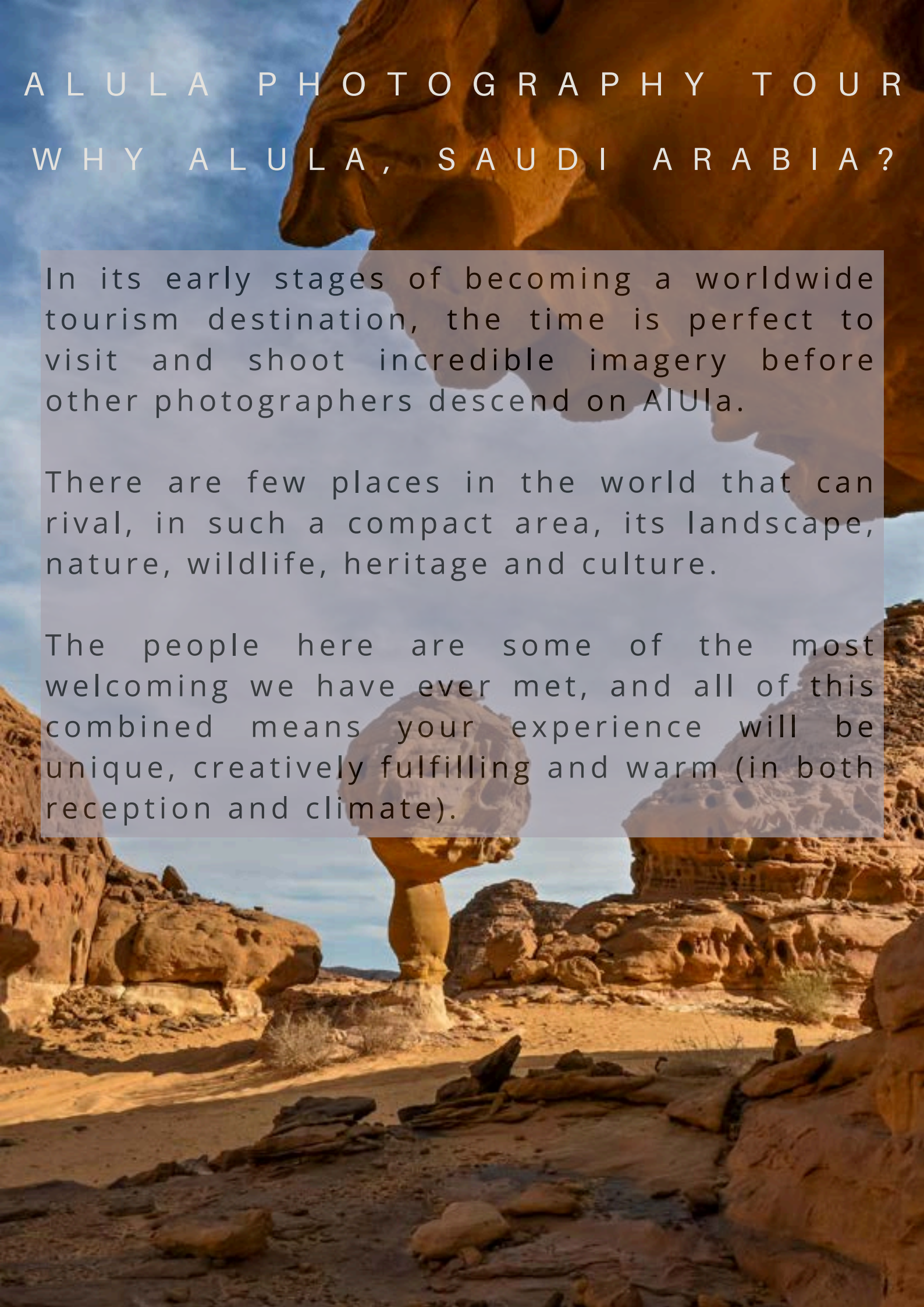
